

COMMENT ON THE DISCUSSION MEETING re:

'The Detection of extra-terrestrial life and the consequences for science and society'

January 25th and 26th 2010, The Royal Society, London, England

As someone who is not from the scientific community, finding myself in the hallowed rooms of The Royal Society in their 350th anniversary year, I was curious as to what this august and academic body would present in discussion of this rather 'out-of-the-box' theme. I was delighted to know that the great Nikola Tesla had addressed an audience here in his heyday, in 1892, making me feel more comfortable in my role as researcher into the multi-faceted subject of ETI/ufology/alternative energy, consciousness and energy medicine, all under the auspices of my Exopolitics hat, and armed with a question from Canadian researcher, Grant Cameron (presidentialufo.com/HillaryClintonUFO.net), for Professor Paul Davies, Arizona State University, whose 1995 book *'Are We Alone the philosophical implications of the discovery of extra-terrestrial life'*, had recently been confirmed (by Tonio Cousin) as being the book Hilary Clinton was holding, whilst photographed in 1995, at a meeting with Laurance Rockefeller at his ranch.

This is of particular interest vis-à-vis the decades long truth embargo by the Government of the UFO/ET subject, which matter was taken seriously by Rockefeller,) and with disclosure in mind, he wrote to Mrs Clinton's office in pursuit of such ideas. History tells us that nothing public came of his initiative, the point being that 'high ups' in Government are aware of the reality of this issue, no matter how they try and deny it. But I digress.

Astrobiology, was a well-represented field at the meeting, and is the '*study of the origin, evolution, distribution and the future of life in the universe and to specifically understand the origin of life and test the hypothesis that life exists elsewhere than on Earth*' according to Prof. Baruch S. Blumberg of Fox Chase Cancer Centre, USA. Current thinking of ('public') science asserts that 'There is at present, no clear evidence that there is life elsewhere than Earth.'

I wondered what the Dogon peoples of Mali, West Africa, who told their stories to two French Anthropologists in 1930, would make of such a statement, when their ancient astronomical histories date back at least to 3200BC certain that amphibian-type beings visited them from Sirius B (and how *did* they know of that pesky Sirius 'B' way before the clever Western civilisation had an inkling of it, and who were only able to photograph it in 1970?) I wonder also what Charles Hall would make of that statement, after his time spent on military duty, with Nellis Air force Base, posted to an isolated weather station, in Indian Springs, only to find he was not alone. The '*Tall Whites*' as he called them, whom he has written about, shared the area. He describes his many encounters with this community of non-human, off planet peoples, who came and went at will in their space ships, (and probably still do) living a life with family members, using Earth as a way station. (<http://www.millennialhospitality.com>) I don't recollect if Charles Hall ever knew where the Tall Whites came from, however, they told him they were here by agreement with the U.S Government in exchange for technology. And shall we completely disregard the many years association Swiss farmer, Billy Meier has had, with very human looking beings he says he has met face to face from the Pleiades, attracting many thousands of researchers, scientific and otherwise over decades. (<http://www.billymeier.com/http://www.theyfly.com>) The world is replete with histories, current and ancient, of myths and legends of contact with ancient astronauts, visitors, and artefacts, buildings, antediluvian submerged pyramids and all manner of physical evidence abounds to support the fact of not only the existence of ETI, but their interaction with humanity.

'The Cosmic Imperative', a phrase coined by Professor, Viscount Christian de Duve allows that life is bound to happen where similar conditions for life arise on a similar planet, and I felt by this, we might be really getting somewhere with our Darwinian friends. It makes much

sense, but then again, what if our science is just one dimensional compared to the different range of frequencies other intelligent life might exist in? How do you prove parallel universes exist or measure other dimensions? And what if scientists are not really interested in seriously addressing the matter of proving human/ET involvement because it is currently seen as professional suicide, where any funding typically would stop, so no income, (historical evidence supports this), and credibility in the eyes of their peers would cease, the media would make sure they were ridiculed, and of course, the ultimate, the threat of death, and many scientists indeed have died for the sake of truth. Giordano Bruno being but one, burnt at the state in 1600 for daring to think outside the box, brazenly expounding the view that the universe is a continuum and our sun is identical in nature as the stars. Fear was expressed, as reflected in some presentations. Charles Cockell, of the Open University, and Chair of the Earth and Space Foundation, a non profit body he established in 1994, said that 'Liberty on Earth could be enslaved by others who control space,' citing the likelihood of tyranny by humans in colonising other bodies, so it seems we do need to have an understanding of the very real implications of what it will mean to engage with other intelligent beings. Simon Conway Morris, (palaeobiology) of the University of Cambridge, UK, fears we are completely alone, that life is a fluke and that should ET call, he warns, 'do not pick up the phone!' Heavens!

Well, I do believe it is a bit late for that one. I think we picked up the phone a long time ago, and have possibly made a pig's ear of things in the translation department, but there is something in wings. There is about to be that incontrovertible, hard evidence that public science wants, and me for that matter. (I make the distinction of public and covert science, because there is clearly knowledge which is not allowed in the public domain, and which many 'public' scientists who are out of this loop, are also unaware of.)

Over the last few years, an almost unacknowledged (at least in the mainstream) milestone in research, has been made in the medical/scientific field, by the courageous efforts of Dr. Roger Leir, (<http://www.alienscalpel.com>) a Podiatrist surgeon, whose work has included retrieving anomalous foreign bodies also known as 'implants', which have turned up in human bodies, which he has been asked to remove. Dr Leir has had extensive analysis work done on these tiny objects, which never cause an inflammatory reaction, and which appear to have nano biotechnology as part of their make up, which some opinions suggest might be tracking and or behavioural devices, providing strong evidence of another aspect of human/ET interaction. I urge the scientific community to research this, and invite Dr Leir to one of their discussion meetings to present his work.

We are on the brink of discovering the 'extraordinary evidence' that will show Life 2.0 or a part thereof, as sought by science to compare us to, as Life 1.0. It is to be found in the ongoing research into the DNA of a 900 year old unusual skull, found in the 1930's in Mexico, that has become known as the '*starchild skull*' (a misnomer, it is not a child) which Anthropologist, Lloyd Pye has custody of. (thestarchildproject.com) His expertise as a researcher of human origins led him down a different road in speculation of the appearance of the modern human, he named it *Intervention Theory* (<http://www.lloydpye.com>) to illustrate how humanity graduated so spectacularly quickly to our current state, (the missing link?) though he will not find friends in the camps of the Darwinian, Creationist or Intelligent Design Corps. Intervention Theory dares to stick its head above the parapet, with a cheeky little concept that may have the latter parties howling it down, and getting the pyre ready (well I hope not the last bit.) Mr Pye posits no less a theory than humanity having had a helping hand in evolving from off-planetary intelligences tweaking our DNA, and the starchild skull is on the cards to prove it. Many tests have been done on this extraordinary relic over the last ten years. The testing of the mitochondrial DNA has been done, and we know the mother was human, but so far, none of the nuclear DNA testing (six attempts), reveals dad, something strange there, but for proof positive, further DNA testing to recover the entire genome needs to be done, and these costs have not yet been met. Once the funds are available (apprx \$500, 00) to ensure testing and evidence by way of filming the test, it is expected that the

starchild skull will prove our ETI linkage, which will create some interesting questions to say the least.

It was with some interest that I listened to Professor Ted Peters from the Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary in the USA discuss a survey re ETI, and possible effects on the major religions, I have extrapolated just one question that was asked, as a good example, and I am not surprised by the response. The question was whether *'official confirmation of the discovery of a civilisation of intelligent beings on another planet would so undercut my beliefs that my beliefs would face a crisis.'*

It was a delight to see Dr Frank Drake, of the SETI Institute, known particularly for his special equation (1961), that gave us a formula calculate the potential number of extra-terrestrial civilisations in our galaxy, with which we might come into some contact, which brings in a figure of around 10,000. This is not the place for greater discussion of this, save that SETI is still searching, and so far, publicly, has not got much further, but in the fifty years or so since its inception, there have been great strides made with understanding the great depth and vastness, as dear Hubble has shown us.

Professor Paul Davies was kind enough to answer my question, which pertained to recent confirmation that his 1995 book, 'Are We Alone, philosophical implications of the discovery of extra-terrestrial life' as mentioned at the beginning of this article. The question was 'had he had discussions with Rockefeller or the Clintons on the subject' (of ETs). Professor Davies response was to say that he had only just been made aware of the fact himself, and he was sure his publisher would be delighted, and that he had been invited to dinner by Rockefeller, but had been unable to attend. Thus putting to rest for the moment, speculation as to whether Professor Davies might have been part of an advisory party in Mr Rockefeller's search for avenues into how disclosure might be brought about.

In coming to the end of my discourse, I would like to highlight the talk given by Professor Albert A. Harrison, University of California, Davis - Social Psychology, amongst other things, he has served on NASA's Space Human Factors Element science and Technology Working Group. His conclusions over his years of research show that most people's response to ET would not be problematical. He cited the hyped up media circus ring of Orson Welles' 'War of the Worlds, which *did not* cause great panic, with the odd exception. Most people at that time, 1938, did not panic or get hysterical, but the media would have you believe differently! Ultimately there would be no major response to ET, any perturbation ill naturally be followed by equilibrium. His other observations were that most people's perception of ET's were Star Trek, Dr Who and such like, and the main problem there might be in the current climate, is the people's lack of trust in government which may pose a problem in communicating such facts of ET to the people, however, a 1997 Marist Poll showed 86% of people expect ET to be friendly, (at least in Western Societies).

The last speaker of the day was Dr Mazlan Othuman, Director of the United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs in Vienna. She spoke on the structure at the U.N. of the bodies that deal with laws of how space is to be treated and that protocols were in place to protect it. Be that as it may, and it is of vital importance how we do behave outside the front door of our planet, there was no where to be seen or heard anything in these hallowed walls about the reality of ETI other than in the form of microbes or other tiny life forms.

I will let Professor Paul Davies have the last word or two: 'Are aliens a threat to human exclusivity or superiority? Yes.....It is a sobering fact that we would be at a stage of spiritual development very inferior to that of almost all of our intelligent alien neighbours.
